1. **Choose a college to find out more about.** Search by College or by Career Pathway.
  - a. If you know which school you are interested in, type the name of a college in “by college” search box.
    - Click on a “Pathway for this Program of Study” for a nearby high school.
    - On the career pathway page for the high school, look for “Post-Secondary Connections” to find local colleges that offer programs related to that career pathway.
  - b. To search by career interest, click “More Options” under the “by career pathway” box.
    - Type the name of an occupation in “search careers by keyword.”
    - Click on the career name. On the next page, choose a nearby high school.
    - On the career pathway page for the high school, look for “Post-Secondary Connections” to find local colleges that offer programs related to that career pathway.
